Overview of UNDESA-DSPD

Our mission is to promote sustainable, equitable and inclusive development. Within this context, DSPD seeks to strengthen international cooperation for social development particularly in the areas of:

- 1. Poverty Eradication
- 2. Productive Employment and Decent Work
- 3. Social Inclusion








Overview of ECOSOC

- Provides substantive leadership to the UN system on development issues
- Plays a key role in promoting the balanced integration of the three dimensions of sustainable development
- Works with Member States, policymakers, NGOs, and other stakeholders to achieve its mandate
- A new High-Level Political Forum (HLPF) on sustainable development convenes every year for 8 days.





Working with ECOSOC: an NGOs Guide to Consultative Status

An NGO with consultative status can:

- Attend international meetings/events;
- Make statements;
- Organize side events;
- Access UN premises to network and lobby, etc.



Commission for Social Development - CSocD

- CSocD is one of the ten functional commissions of ECOSOC
- Improves international understanding on social development
- Reviews relevant UN programmes of action related to social groups
- Identifies emerging issues affecting social development

- The priority theme of CSocD54 is "Rethinking and strengthening social development in the contemporary world"
- CSocD54 will be the first session after the adoption of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.
- Three panel discussions will take place highlighting concrete policies/strategies.
