Non-agricultural informal employment: 82 % South Asia, 66% sub-Saharan Africa, 65% East and South-East Asia (excluding China), 51% Latin America and 10% Eastern Europe and Central Asia. (ILO,2013)




Formalization is a means and not an end

Main challenges





An integrated approach incorporates a greater degree of:
