

Christian Renoux is Associate Professor of Early Modern History at the University of Orleans (France). He completed his studies in the Ecole Normale Supérieure and his PhD at the University of Paris I - La Sorbonne.

Conscientious objector, Christian was Co-President of the Mouvement international de la Réconciliation (MIR), the French Branch of the International Fellowship of the Reconciliation (IFOR) from 1994 to 2005 and he was a member of the Steering Committee of IFOR from 1996 to 2000.

He is currently editor of the Cahiers de la Réconciliation (Paris), a magazine of the French speaking branches of IFOR. He is Co-Initiator and President of the French Coalition and of the International Coalition for the UN Decade for the Promotion of a Culture of Peace and Non-Violence for the Children of the World (2001-2010). The French Coalition for the Decade has co-organized in Paris in June 2004 the first international Salon of Peace Initiatives (115 organizations, 10 000 visitors) and is organizing the second international Salon of Peace Initiatives in June 2006 in Paris within the International Conference "Acting for a Culture of Peace and Nonviolence".

A nonviolence trainer, Christian Renoux has worked in France, Italy, Congo-Brazzaville, Democratic Republic of Congo and Togo. He is the Vice President of Partage, a French organization of child sponsorship.
