Graham Hassall is Professor of Governance at the Pacific Institute for Advanced Studies in Development and Governance, at the University of the South Pacific. He completed his undergraduate studies in history and in education at the University of Sydney and the University of New South Wales, and his PhD in Pacific history at the Australian National University. He is currently engaged in collaborative projects with UNDP (Fiji Office), the Pacific Islands Forum Secretariat, and the Fiji Government's Ministry of Reconciliation and National Unity. These projects include coordination of the 3rd Pacific Human Development Report, an analysis of the peace accords and treaties in the Pacific region, participation in multi-stake-holder dialogues in Fiji's reconciliation process; and convening of the 3rd Asia Pacific Mediation Forum in Fiji in 2006.
