

Creation of a network of partner countries for south – south solidarity

Establishing an inter-governmental alliance, made up of developing countries.



Missions:

- The mission of partners involves :
- Developing and improving the south south collaboration in the field of solidarity and poverty alleviation.
- Building member countries institutional capacities in order to carry out south south exchange activities.
- Identifying the best opportunities offered by NEPAD...
- Initiating long term collaboration agreements.
- Launching resource mobilisation programmes.
- Establishing a secretariat which would serve as a focal point for the networking between the partner countries and which would make it possible to identify the exchange possibilities and the resources for south south financial assistance.
- Partnership is an alliance in the form of a network with an approach based on a strong synergy of programme implementation;
- Developing concerted intervention strategies to address emergency situations in member countries.

The Governing Board

 - Advocating to get greater support from donors for south south cooperation relations;
 - Supporting resource mobilisation efforts
