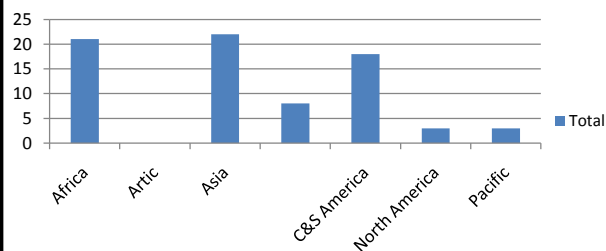
Trust Fund on Indigenous Issues relating to the Second International Decade of the World's Indigenous People: Summary on funded projects.



From 2006 to 2009, the Trust Fund on Indigenous Issues has granted a total of 75 projects with a predominance of projects in Asia, Africa and Central and East Europe and Caucasus. Because of its limited resources, the Trust Fund has however only been able to grant funds to 75 out of a total of 485 projects submitted and approved for consideration by the Bureau of the UNPFII, acting as the Advisory Group. The projects have mostly been in the areas of human rights (41% of the projects) and Social and Economic Development (20% of the projects). The target population has in 55% of the projects been the population in general along with 21% focusing specifically on women and 21% on youth. The projects have mainly been implemented with a local focus (80%), with a majority in the rural areas (68%).

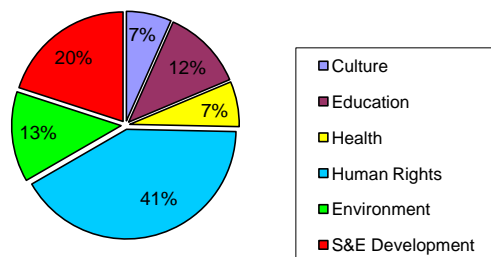

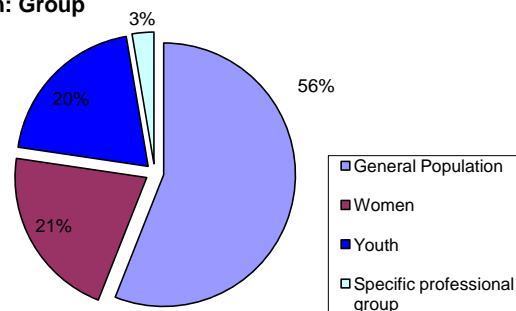

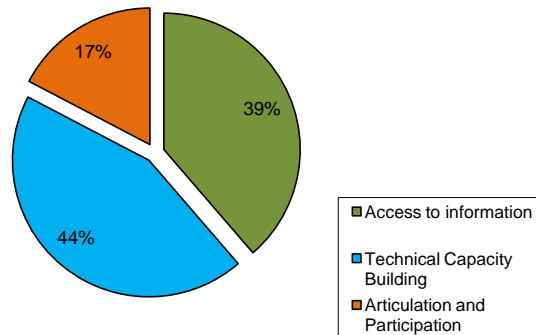
