Annotations

1. Election of officers

Rule 15 of the rules of procedure of the functional commissions of the Economic and Social Council stipulates that, at the commencement of the first meeting of a regular session, the Commission shall elect from among the representatives of its members a Chairperson, one or more Vice-Chairpersons and such other officers as may be required. Following the established practice, the Commission shall elect a Chairperson, three Vice-Chairpersons and a Rapporteur or Vice-Chairperson with rapporteurial responsibilities (Vice-Chairperson-cum-Rapporteur).

In accordance with subparagraph (c) of its decision 2002/210 of 13 February 2002, the Economic and Social Council decided that immediately following the closure of a regular session, the Commission for Social Development would hold the first meeting of its subsequent regular session for the sole purpose of electing the new Chairperson and other members of the Bureau. In pursuance of this decision, at the first meeting of the forty-fifth session of the Commission, on 22 March 2006, the Commission elected the following officers by acclamation: Francis Lorenzo (Dominican Republic) and Hedda Samson (Netherlands) as Vice-Chairpersons.

The Group of Asian States and the Group of African States subsequently nominated Mehdi Danesh-Yazdi (Islamic Republic of Iran) as Chairperson-elect of the Commission and Joyce Kafanabo (United Republic of Tanzania) as Vice-Chairperson-elect, respectively. The Eastern European Group of States agreed that Ukraine would nominate a Vice-Chairperson to represent the Group on the Bureau. The Chairperson and the remaining Vice-Chairpersons will be elected at the opening meeting of the forty-fifth session of the Commission, on 7 February 2007. At the same meeting, one of the Vice-Chairpersons will be designated as having rapporteurial responsibilities.

2. Adoption of the agenda and other organizational matters

Rule 7 of the rules of procedure requires that, after the election of its officers at the beginning of each session, the Commission shall adopt the agenda for that session on the basis of the provisional agenda. The provisional agenda and documentation for the forty-fifth session of the Commission were approved by the Economic and Social Council in its decision 2006/238 of 26 July 2006.

The proposed organization of work of the Commission for Social Development at its forty-fifth session (see annex I) has been prepared pursuant to relevant decisions of the General Assembly and the Economic and Social Council to facilitate the consideration of agenda items within the time frame available and in accordance with the conference services allocated to the Commission. The timetable should be considered tentative and indicative: if the Commission completes its consideration of an item ahead of schedule, it may wish to proceed immediately to the next item.

The Commission is scheduled to meet from Wednesday, 7 February, to Friday, 16 February 2007. Arrangements have been made to hold morning and afternoon meetings during the session: morning meetings will be held from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. and afternoon meetings from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m.

3. Follow-up to the World Summit for Social Development and the twenty-fourth special session of the General Assembly

In accordance with General Assembly resolution 55/46 on the implementation of the outcome of the World Summit for Social Development and of the twenty-fourth special session of the General Assembly entitled “World Summit for Social Development and beyond: achieving social development for all in a globalizing world”, the Commission will undertake regular assessment of the implementation of the Copenhagen commitments and the further initiatives adopted at Geneva.

(a) Priority theme: promoting full employment and decent work for all

In its resolution 2005/11 of 21 July 2005 on the future organization and methods of work of the Commission, the Economic and Social Council decided that, beginning with its forty-fifth session, the work of the Commission would be organized in a series of two-year action-oriented implementation cycles, which would include a review segment and a policy segment.

Subsequently, in its resolution 2006/18 of 26 July 2006 on the same subject, the Council decided that the theme for the 2007-2008 review and policy cycle would be “Promoting full employment and decent work for all”, taking into account its interrelationship with poverty eradication and social integration. In the same resolution, the Council also decided that the outcome of the Commission’s review should be in the form of a chairperson’s summary, done in close coordination with other members of the Bureau, and that the policy segment should have a negotiated outcome with action-oriented strategies.

The Commission, at its forty-fifth session, will be called upon to nominate a number of new members and to renominate some existing members of the Board. The Council will be called upon to confirm those nominations in 2007.
