

Call for case studies

The Secretariat of the United Nations Commission on Sustainable Development (CSD) invites all stakeholders to make available case studies of lessons learned and best practices in addressing barriers and constraints in the thematic areas of energy for sustainable development, industrial development, air pollution/atmosphere, and climate change – the issues currently on the agenda of the CSD. The case studies will be considered by the Secretariat for inclusion into the CSD Matrix.

The [Matrix](#) is an information tool developed by the CSD Secretariat. It aims to provide user-friendly information on practical experiences in implementation in the thematic areas of energy for sustainable development, industrial development, air pollution/atmosphere, and climate change. It is based on information submitted by Governments, including through national reports; and by UN agencies and Major Groups. It takes into account information contained in Secretary-General's reports and Partnerships for Sustainable Development registered with the CSD Secretariat, as well as information emerging from the regional implementation meetings held before the 14th session of the CSD.

The Matrix is a work in progress. The Secretariat welcomes new submissions of case studies and is continuing to update the Matrix as more information on implementation is received.
