Partnerships Fair during CSD 11

Partnerships for Sustainable Development constitute an important outcome of the Johannesburg World Summit on Sustainable Development (WSSD).

The 11th session of the Commission on Sustainable Development (CSD 11) is expected to discuss and decide on the follow-up process for these partnerships.

In addition to the official discussions a 'Partnerships Fair' will be organized as a parallel activity during CSD 11.

The Partnerships Fair will run from Tuesday, 29 April through Thursday, 8 May 2003.

Purpose

The Partnerships Fair is meant to provide an opportunity for existing and potential new partners of WSSD Partnerships to come to the CSD for networking, creating synergies between partnerships, looking for more partners and/or funding and learning from each other's experiences.

Partners will also have the opportunity to inform about progress with their partnerships since the Johannesburg Summit and to present their ideas on the follow-up process within CSD.

Modalities

A conference room ('Partnerships Room') will be available for the Partnerships Fair from Tuesday, 29 April, through Thursday, 8 May. The CSD Secretariat plans to set up a schedule with daily events of the Partnerships Fair taking place in this room.

The following types of events are suggested:

- > Panel discussions
- > Seminars
- ➤ Match-making sessions
- Presentations
- > Internal meetings of Partnerships

Depending on the interest expressed, one or two of such events might be scheduled per day, while the Partnerships Room would be available for other informal meetings and networking activities of the Partners during the rest of the day.
