## **Energy Efficient Products: Stimulating Demand and Facilitating Trade through Communities of Practice**

### **Synopsis:**

The course will illustrate how targeted policies can facilitate the uptake of energy efficient practices and products. These will be illustrated through a discussion of Australia's national activities and a case study on international cooperative efforts (where the key contributions of China and other economies are acknowledged).

In particular, the session will engage participants in discussion on effective international cooperation through the formation of a "community of practice" as a new type of international cooperation. . The session will feature leading Australian and world energy efficiency experts as instructors, and use practical case studies (on lighting on a global scale) to demonstrate the concepts. The session will close with an interactive panel discussion.
