Putting monitoring and evaluation to work in sustainable energy projects

Synopsis:

This learning centre course will use the Monitoring & Evaluation (M&E) guide as a platform to explain the necessary elements and methodology of an energy monitoring and evaluation programme and examine how this is done at the project level. The course will highlight experiences from the field, most notably in Africa, where this methodology is being tested in the COOPENER Development and Energy in Africa Programme led by the RISO National Laboratory in Denmark. This will be a practical, hands-on course for policymakers and development practitioners to better understand how to quantify the impacts and outcomes of the energy projects in their country.
