

**Call for written contributions from major groups**

The 14<sup>th</sup> session of the Commission on Sustainable Development (DSD-14) will undertake a review of progress achieved in the implementation of the goals and targets in the thematic cluster of “Energy, air pollution/atmosphere, climate change, and industrial development”, as contained in Agenda 21, the Programme for the Further Implementation of Agenda 21 and the Johannesburg Plan of Implementation.

The CSD Secretariat encourages and welcomes written contributions from major groups on their results-oriented activities on implementation. Data and information should be provided in the form of factual evidence. Contributions submitted before the deadlines (shown below) will be considered in the preparation of the official documentation for CSD-14, including:

- (a) Secretary-General's State of Implementation reports in each of the thematic issues of energy, air pollution/atmosphere, climate change, and industrial development providing detailed reviews of progress of implementation at all levels and also reflecting new challenges and opportunities to expedite implementation.
- (b) Secretary-General's Overview report reviewing progress achieved in the overall implementation of Agenda 21, the Programme for Further Implementation of Agenda 21 and the Johannesburg Plan of Implementation (excluding the issues reviewed in the Secretary-General's State of Implementation reports).

**Reporting Deadline**

Written contributions from major groups should reach the CSD Secretariat not later than **1 September 2005**. Earlier submissions are encouraged. In providing such contributions, major groups are requested to use the enclosed template. Contributions should be faxed or e-mailed to:
