### **Annotations**

### 1. Election of officers

The Committee may wish to elect a Chairman, Vice-Chairs and Rapporteur(s), taking into consideration that the Committee comprises two sub-groups of twelve members each dealing with issues of energy and water resources.

## 2. Adoption of the agenda and organization of work

The provisional agenda contains items on issues in the energy and the water sectors that emerged after the cancelled sessions respectively of the former Committee on Natural Resources and the Committee on New and Renewable Sources of Energy and on Energy for Development and it is also based on the provisional agendas of those cancelled sessions.

# 3. Contribution to the preparatory process for the ninth session of the Commission on Sustainable Development

In resolution 1998/47, the Economic and Social Council called for a special relationship between the work programme of the Committee and that of the Commission on Sustainable Development, and to ensure that the Committee's work programme will be structured in a manner that could enable it to contribute to the work of the Commission. In the multi-year work programme of the Commission, the sectoral theme of the ninth session of the Commission will be Atmosphere/Energy and the topic for the economic sector of the session will be Energy/Transport. Preparations of the ninth session of the Commission is to be initiated at its seventh session scheduled for 19 to 30 April 1999. Thus, the first session of the Committee would provide an opportunity for it to contribute substantively to the preparatory process at the very initial stage.

# 4. Contribution to the preparation of the Report of the Secretary-General on progress made in providing safe water supply and sanitation during the 1990s, to be submitted to the eighth session of the Commission on Sustainable Development

Taking into consideration the special relationship called for in ECOSOC resolution 1998/47 mentioned in item 3 above, as well as General Assembly resolution 50/126, in which it requested the Secretary-General to submit a report to its fifty-fifth session, through both the eighth session of the Commission on Sustainable Development and ECOSOC, the first session of the Committee could contribute to the preparation of the report.
