

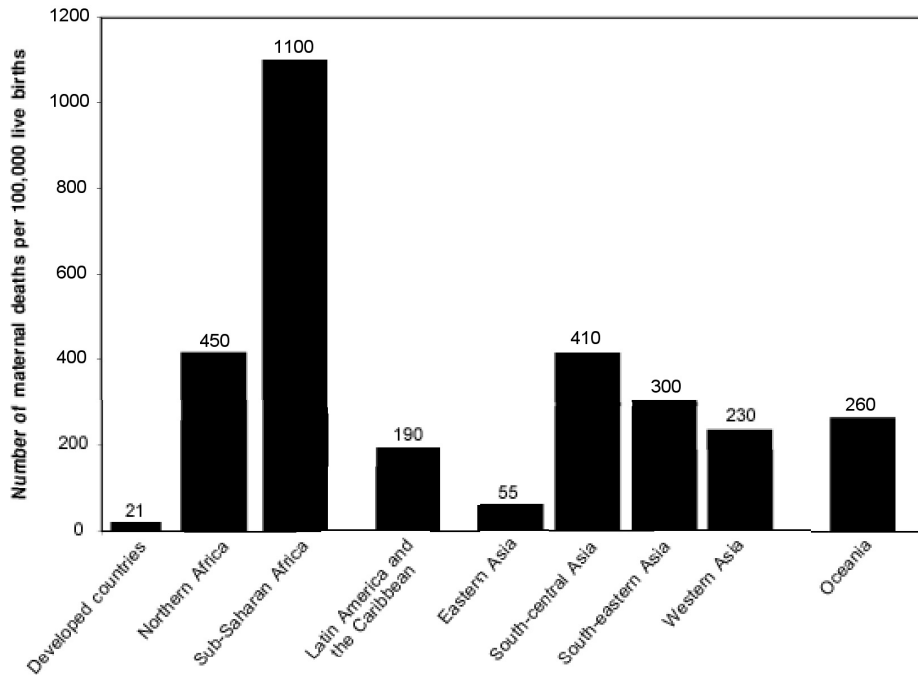


## Goal 5 - Improve maternal health

Target: Reduce by three quarters, between 1990 and 2015, the maternal mortality ratio

Based on best estimates for 1995, maternal mortality is far higher in all developing regions, compared to developed, and fifty times higher in sub-Saharan Africa.

ESTIMATES OF MATERNAL MORTALITY RATIOS



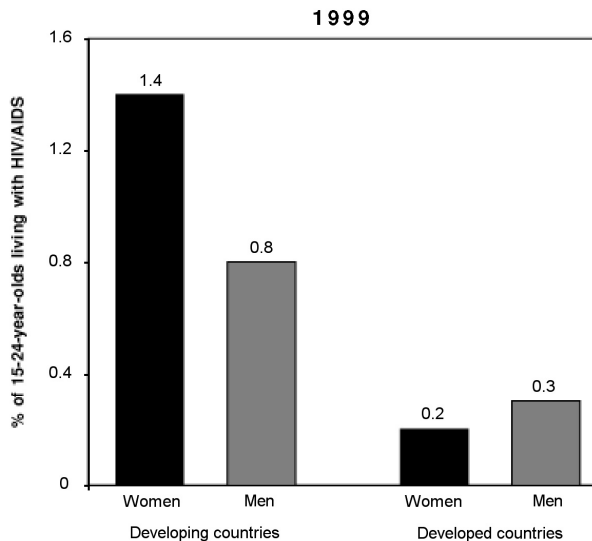

## Goal 6 - Combat HIV/AIDS, malaria and other diseases

Target: By 2015, to have halted and begun to reverse the spread of HIV/AIDS

HIV prevalence rates are still increasing for men and women in the developing world. The rate is seven times higher in developing countries than developed countries for women, and almost three times higher for men.
