In spite of increased resources for AIDS and progress towards universal access, coverage of essential HIV services for many key populations (e.g. sex workers, drug users, men who have sex with men, prisoners) remains alarmingly low. Target setting for universal access has not sufficiently addressed the needs of many marginalised communities. In addition, with key donors moving to increase funding through budget support, many marginalised populations are likely to be left out.
