
Excellency,

I have the honour to bring to your attention a letter dated 22 January 2007 by the Permanent Representative of Cuba addressed to me in his capacity as Chair of the Coordinating Bureau of the Non-Aligned Movement (copy attached).

In his letter, the Permanent Representative of Cuba requested a debate to be scheduled in the General Assembly jointly under agenda item 47 (Integrated and coordinated implementation of and follow-up to the outcomes of the major United Nations conferences and summits in the economic, social and related fields), agenda item 113 (Follow-up to the outcome of the Millennium Summit) and agenda item 149 (United Nations reform: measures and proposals) in order to discuss the progress achieved in the work of the Peacebuilding Commission.

In this connection, please be advised that it is my intention to schedule a plenary meeting for Tuesday, 6 February 2007.
