Minister Fernando Bustamante is a sociologist that earned his degree at the Catholic University of Chile. He holds a diploma in Regional and Urban Planning from the Latin-American Institute of Economic and Social Studies, an organ of the Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean –ECLAC-.

He holds a Master graduate degree in Regional and Urban Planning from the Inter disciplinary Center for Urban Development from the Catholic University of Chile (CIDU). He is a Master in Public Administration from Harvard University, Cambridge, Massachusetts.

Among his professional posts he's been consultant in several organizations in Chile as well as his native Ecuador, among them at the Panamerican Health Organization, Central Bank of Ecuador, and the Latin American Faculty of Social Studies (FLACSO) and UNICEF.

Minister Bustamante is a professor at the School of Sociology of the University Academy of Christian Humanity in Santiago, Chile and also teaches for the Masters Program in Social Studies at the same University. He was Coordinator at the Master of Political Sciences at FLACSO-Ecuador, professor of the Diplomatic Academy of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Ecuador.
