Excellency,

In General Assembly resolution 58/126, "Revitalization of the work of the General Assembly", Annex A "Enhancing the authority and role of the General Assembly" par. 7, the President-elect of the General Assembly is to propose an issue, or issues, of global concern upon which member states will be invited to comment during the general debate at the forthcoming session of the Assembly.

Therefore and after consultations I propose the issues upon which Member States are invited to comment during the general debate of the 63<sup>rd</sup> session of the General Assembly to be as follows:

"The impact of the global food crisis on poverty and hunger in the world as well as the need to democratize the United Nations."

The issue for comment – as stated in the above resolution- will be without prejudice to the sovereign right of Member States to solely and entirely determine the content of their general statements.

May I kindly request that your Excellency circulate this letter to all Member States for their perusal.
