Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to resolution 60/288 entitled “The United Nations Global Counter-Terrorism Strategy” which was adopted by consensus in September 2006 as well as resolution 62/272 under which Member States reviewed implementation of the Strategy in 2008.

By paragraph 14 of resolution 62/272, the General Assembly decided to “include in the provisional agenda of the sixty-fourth session an item entitled “The United Nations Global Counter-Terrorism Strategy” in order to undertake in two years an examination of the report of the Secretary-General requested in paragraph 13 above, as well as the implementation of the Strategy on the part of Member States and to consider updating the Strategy to respond to changes”.

In this regard, I am pleased to inform you that His Excellency Mr. Abulkalam Abdul Momen, Permanent Representative of the People’s Republic of Bangladesh has agreed to serve as Facilitator to lead the consultations among Member States. I would like to thank him for accepting this important task.

I trust that all Member States will give Ambassador Momen their full support and cooperation to enable conclusion of this crucial and collective undertaking in a timely manner within this session. Member States will soon be informed of the first meeting of the consultations.
