United Nations High-level Event on the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs)

New York, 25 September 2008

The Government of the Republic of Korea has decided to:

- 1. Set the mid-term target of the ODA/GNI at 0.25% by 2015, representing a six-fold increase from 0.04% in 2000. With this target in place, Korea's ODA is expected to reach around 3.3 billion dollars in 2015,
- 2. Make a contribution of 100 million dollars over the next 3 years for emergency food relief through the World Food Programme (WFP) and for technical cooperation to increase agricultural productivity in developing countries, and
- 3. Launch the 'East Asia Climate Partnership' programme, which includes the funding of 200 million dollars over the next 5 years to support the countries in East Asia in making their economic growth compatible with climate change.
