This side event to the UN General Assembly's 'Special Event to follow up on efforts made towards achieving the MDGs' will present the findings from two participatory research projects. 'Setting the **post-2015 development compass: voices from the ground**' and 'My Rights Beyond 2015' were carried out by CAFOD and Trócaire to promote a post-2015 development framework that is grounded in the views of people living in poverty. The research projects collected experiences of change and development priorities of those living in poverty, asking them to evaluate the MDGs and the new development framework.


