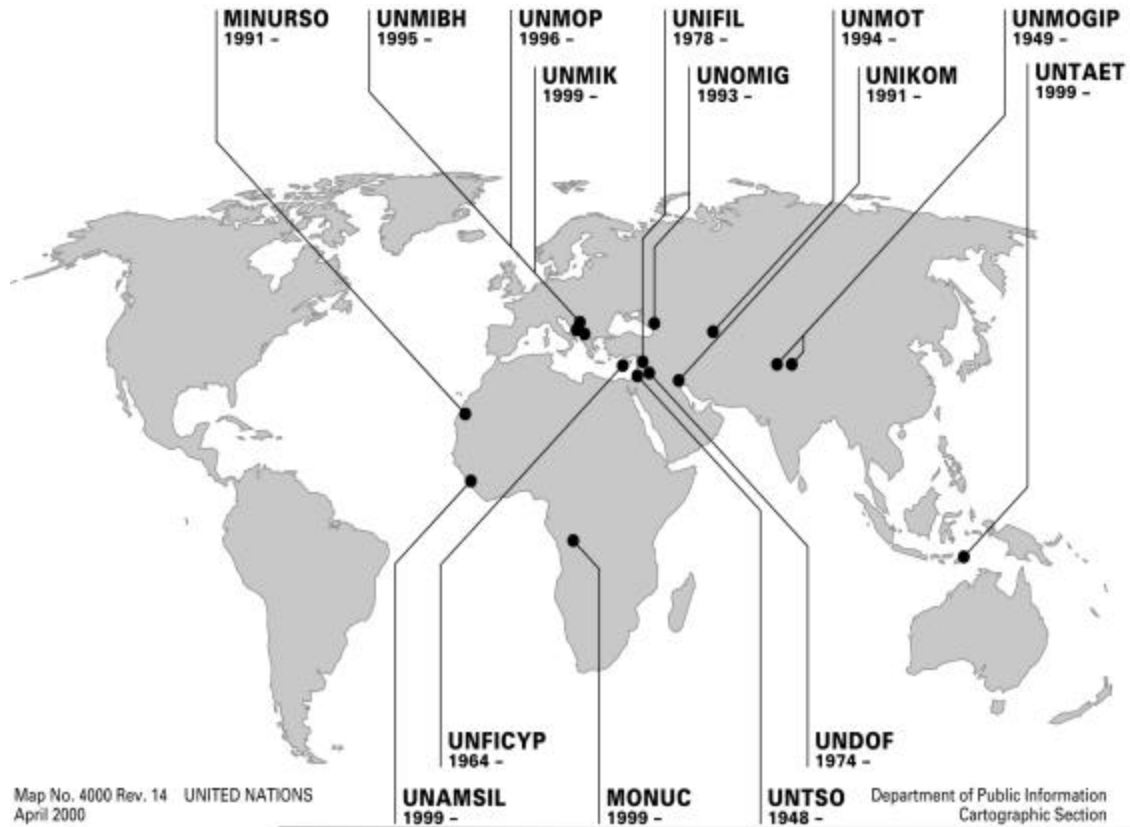

**NOTE:** UNTSO and UNMOGIP are funded from the United Nations regular budget. Costs to the United Nations of the 13 other current operations are financed from their own separate accounts on the basis of legally binding assessments on all Member States. For these missions, budget estimates and appropriations indicated on the reverse side are, in most cases, for one year from 1 July 1999 to 30 June 2000. Military personnel refers to military observers and/or troops, as applicable. International civilian figures are as of 29/02/00, and local civilian figures are as of 31/01/00, except where otherwise indicated.
