

**PEACEBUILDING SUPPORT OFFICE (PBSO)
FUNCTIONAL ORGANIGRAMME**

Office of the Assistant Secretary-General

- Coordinate strategic policy advice and support to the PBC.
- Advise the SG on peacebuilding issues through convening the relevant entities of the UN system to strategize on peacebuilding and provide coherent UN system support to the work of the PBC.
- Provide overall management of the PBSO and the PBF; delivery of all mandated PBSO outputs and reports; coordinate and ensure PBSO resources are effectively managed.

Policy Analysis Section

- Provide technical policy support to the PBC (*incl. provision of best practices and succinct analysis for thematic PBC discussions*).
- Promote integrated approaches, policy guidance, and best practices for the Secretary-General and UN system (*incl. at HQ and country-level*).
- Advance knowledge management and establish a peacebuilding community of practice.
- Conduct outreach to external partners, with emphasis towards academic and policy research institutions.

Strategic Planning Section

- Provide substantive support to the PBC regarding countries under consideration by PBC.
- Develop peacebuilding strategies to lay the foundations for sustainable peace.
- Support peacebuilding efforts in countries (*incl. direct support to countries before the PBC, and capacity-building efforts to strengthen national actors at the country-level*).
- Coordinate peacebuilding within the UN system.

External Relations Section

- Provide secretariat support to the PBC (*incl. extensive procedural assistance to the Organizational Committee and Country-Specific Meeting*).
- Undertake communications, outreach and media relations.
- Conduct Donor/NGO liaison.
- Provide oversight and programmatic management of the PBF
- Analyze and track financing for peacebuilding
