UN UNDER SECRETARY GENERAL VISITS TIMOR-LESTE

The UN Under Secretary General for Internal Oversight Services, Dileep Nair arrived in Dili today for a three-day visit.

During his visit, Mr. Nair is scheduled to meet with Deputy Special Representative of Secretary General, Sukehiro Hasegawa and UNMISSET Heads of Units.

Mr. Nair will also travel to Oecussi to meet with the Peacekeeping Forces, UNPOL and Timor-Leste Police Service District Commanders, the District Administrator and his international advisor, as well as the Regional Services Co-ordinator.

The Under Secretary General is accompanied by his Special Assistant, Tay Keong Tan, and will depart Timor-Leste on Thursday, October 10.

MEETING OF UN REPRESENTATIVES

The SRSG, Kamallesh Sharma is currently attending a seminar for all specials and personal representatives and envoys of the UN Secretary General.

The three-day seminar held in Mont Pelerin, Switzerland started on 7 October and ends tomorrow. On his way back, Mr. Sharma will pay an official visit to Singapore and to the Philippines.

MEETING ON TRADING ZONES

United Nations Military Observers (UNMO) attended a meeting with Indonesia Army (TNI) and Police (POLRI) on the weekend, focusing on illegal trading along the tactical co-ordination line. Both agencies discussed measures to control illegal trade and procedures for people to attend Mota Ain border market.

The weekly co-ordination meeting in Passabe, Oecussi district between Korean PKF and TNI confirmed procedures for people to cross the tactical co-ordination line with the use of temporary passes in special cases.

Timor-Leste nationals will still require an official document from the District Administrator in order to attend weddings, but will only need to submit a form of ID in order to attend funerals.
