HUMAN RIGHTS TRAINING

Timor Lorosae Police Service (TLPS) Vulnerable Persons Unit (VPU) and Bobonaro District Human Rights Office conducted a half-day Vulnerable Persons and Human Rights Training Workshop in Bilimau, Kailaco Sub-District in Ermera yesterday.

The workshop is part of the VPU and HRU's July - October program to raise community awareness regarding protection of human rights of vulnerable persons, including returnees, women, children, the mentally ill and victims of rape and domestic violence.
