Excellency,

You will recall that, on 1 December 2016, former Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon briefed the General Assembly on the United Nations' New Approach to Cholera in Haiti. Following that briefing, the General Assembly adopted resolution A/RES/71/161, in which it requested the Secretary-General to submit a further report on the topic for consideration at its resumed seventy-first session.

The Secretary-General has now issued the report mandated by the General Assembly on New Approach to Cholera in Haiti (A/71/895) outlining the progress made towards the two-track approach mentioned in the first report.

I have been requested by the Deputy-Secretary-General to convene an informal briefing of the General Assembly on the latest report. The briefing will take place on Wednesday, 14 June from $3:00~\rm p.m.-5:00~\rm p.m.$ in the Trusteeship Council Chamber. Please note there will be no formal list of speakers.
