On 10 September 2014, the General Assembly adopted a resolution 68/307 on the revitalization of the work of the General Assembly.

In this resolution, Member States decided to establish at its sixty-ninth session an Adhoc Working Group on the revitalization of the Work of the General Assembly, open to all Member States, in order “ to identify further ways to enhance the role, authority, effectiveness and efficiency of the Assembly, inter alia, by building on the progress achieved in past sessions as well as on previous resolutions, including evaluating the status of their implementation and to submit a report thereon to the Assembly at its sixty-ninth session.”

I have the honour to inform you that I have appointed H.E Mr. Vladimir Drobnjak, Permanent Representative of Croatia and H.E Mr. Wilfred I. Emvula, the Permanent Representative of Namibia, to serve as Co-Chairs of the Adhoc Working Group during the sixty-ninth session.

I would like to thank Ambassador Drobnjak and Ambassador Emvula for accepting this important responsibility and trust that you will extend full support and cooperation to them.
