Excellency,

By its resolution 69/1 of 19 September 2014, the General Assembly welcomed the intention of the Secretary-General to establish the United Nations Mission for Ebola Emergency Response and called upon Member States, relevant United Nations bodies and the United Nations system to provide their full support to the Mission.

In view of recent developments, I would like to inform you that I will convene an informal meeting of the plenary on the public health crisis emanating from the Ebola virus outbreak.

In this regard, I have invited Dr. David Nabarro, Special Envoy of the Secretary-General on Ebola and Mr. Anthony Banbury, Special Representative and Head of the United Nations Mission for Ebola Emergency Response (UNMEER), to brief the membership on this pressing matter.

The briefing will take place on Friday, 10 October 2014, at 11.00 a.m. in the ECOSOC Chamber.
