**Press Release****UNOWA/CNMC/2005/1****Meeting of the Cameroon-Nigeria Mixed Commission  
Joint Technical Team on Demarcation  
Abuja, 7-9 February 2005**

**UNOWA, Dakar – 04 February 2005.** The Cameroon-Nigeria Mixed Commission is holding a meeting of its Demarcation Joint Technical Team (JTT) from 7 to 9 February 2005 in Abuja. The meeting is taking place in the aftermath of the UN Secretary-General's visit to Cameroon and Nigeria.

During this meeting, the JTT will examine about 20 preliminary maps produced by the UN Cartographic Section on various parts of the border.

Participants are also expected to discuss the work plan for demarcation activities, including a revised time plan, and to undertake the operational planning for the field assessment, scheduled to begin in March 2005.

The Demarcation Joint Technical Team (JTT) is composed of technical experts from both Cameroon and Nigeria and from the United Nations. Its role is to carry out a field assessment of the boundary and to supervise the demarcation works carried out by outside contractors.
