Joint Technical Team on Demarcation  
Yaounde 7-8 December 2004**

**UNOWA, Dakar - 06 December 2004.** The Cameroon-Nigeria Mixed Commission is holding a meeting of its Demarcation Joint Technical Team on 7 and 8 December 2004 in Yaounde.

The Demarcation Joint Technical Team (JTT) is composed of technical experts from both parties and from the United Nations and is in charge of the technical aspects of the demarcation process of the land boundary between Cameroon and Nigeria.

This meeting is taking place at an interesting moment for this process which has recently seen progress. Preliminary maps have been produced by the UN Cartographic Section and will be examined by the JTT.

The meeting will also be provided with an update by the Mixed Commission Senior Consultant, Mr. Bill Robertson and by Mr. Hiroshi Murakami, Head of the Cartographic Section at the United Nations Headquarters in New York.

The meeting will also discuss the upcoming technical work including verification field visits and will adopt a programme of work for the actual demarcation exercise.
