**Follow – up Committee:
Fifth Meeting on 19 March 2007**

Dakar – 16 March 2007 - The Follow – up Committee, in charge of monitoring the implementation of the Greentree Agreement of 12 June 2006 will hold its fifth meeting in Geneva on 19 March 2007.

The Committee, composed of representatives of Cameroon, Nigeria, the United Nations Organization, and the four witness countries (Germany, United States of America, France and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland) held its fourth meeting on 15 December 2006, in Geneva.

Further to the ruling of the International Court of Justice of 10 October 2002, the peaceful withdrawal of armed forces and the transfer of authority over the Bakassi Peninsula of 14 August 2006, has followed those in the Lake Chad area in December 2003, and along the land boundary in July 2004.

Since the withdrawal and transfer of authority last August, the UN civilian observers of the Mixed Commission have not noticed any activity of the parties in contradiction to their obligations.
