* UNRWA's Relief and Recovery Appeal for Nahr el-Bared Camp* – Lebanon 2008-2009 incorporates all of the Agency's emergency funding needs in support of the 27,000 Palestine refugees displaced from NBC and its adjacent areas in northern Lebanon in mid-2007 as a result of the conflict between the Lebanese Armed Forces and the Fatah Al-Islam group. Total funding requirements between September 2008 to December 2009 are estimated at US\$42,7 million.
