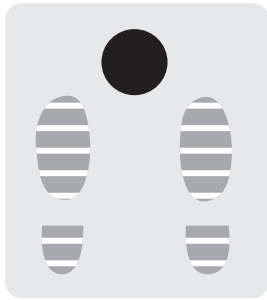

The Human Right to Water



Between
50 and 100
liters of water per person
per day are needed
to ensure most basic
needs (1)



The water source
has to be within
1,000
meters from home (1)



Water cost should
not exceed **3** per
cent of household
income (2)



Collection time
should not exceed
30 minutes (1)
