# Winner of 1 million US dollar UN-DESA Energy Grant to be revealed at Ceremony

The recipient of the 1 million US dollar UN-DESA Energy Grant 'Powering the Future We Want' will be revealed at an awards ceremony taking place from 11am to 12:30pm on Monday, 14 September 2015, at UN Headquarters in New York, Conference Room 2.

#### WHAT

The work of the top ten applicants to the United Nations Department of Economic and Social Affairs (UN-DESA) energy grant will be briefly illustrated, demonstrating how energy plays a central role in promoting progress towards the economic, social and environmental dimensions of sustainable development. The winner of the grant will be revealed.

The "Powering the Future We Want" grant offers one million US dollars to fund capacity development activities in energy for sustainable development. It seeks to encourage dissemination and scaling up of successful experiences and best practices in this area. The Grant is awarded to an individual, institution or partnership based on past and current achievements.
