DESCRIPTION:

Selected girl activists representing diverse issues and communities will speak on the work they are doing to address issues impacting girls globally; around the issues of marginalized girls, girls in politics and girls supporting girls. The artistic performances accompanying the girl activists will be direct representations of girls' experiences and stories from around the world.

PARTICIPANTS:

The program will feature 4-5 girl activists/activist groups speaking about their work. Additional 5-7 girls will deliver selected spoken word performances. WGG Girl Advocates will moderate and/or serve as performers or subject presenters in the Girls Speak Out.

EVENT HOSTS:

The Working Group on Girls (WGG) and the Governments of Canada, Peru & Turkey at the United Nations will host the 2016 IDG Girls Speak Out. The WGG is a coalition of over 75 non-governmental organizations dedicated to advancing the rights of girls, and assisting them to develop their full potential as women.
