



During the period 2001-2010 in the UN system , the proportion of women appointed increased by 6.8 percentage points , from 33.5% (6,407 out of 19,098) in 2001 to 40.3% (12,005 out of 29,763) in 2010.				During the period 2001- 2010 in IFAD the proportion of women appointed increased by 6.2 percentage points, from 36.7% (61 out of 166) in 2001 to 42.9% (121 out of 282) in 2010.
