



## Trends in the representation of women in the Professional and higher categories – 2003 to 2010

During the period **2001-2010 in the UN system**, the proportion of women appointed increased by **6.8 percentage points**, from **33.5%**(6,407 out of 19,098) in 2001 to **40.3%** (12,005 out of 29,763) in 2010.

During the period **2003- 2010 in UNWTO**, the proportion of women appointed increased by **1.9** percentage points, from **31.4%** (11 out of 35) in 2003 to **33.3%** (13 out of 39) in 2010.
