



Trends in the representation of women in the P During the period 2001-2010 in the UN system , the proportion of women appointed increased by 6.8 percentage points , from 33.5% (6,407 out of 19,098) in 2001 to 40.3% (12,005 out of 29,763) in 2010.				Professional and higher categories – 2001 to 2010During the period 2001- 2010 in WFP the proportion of women appointed increased by 4.3percentage points, from 36.8% (308 out of 838) in 2001 to 41.1% (600 out of 1461) in 2010.
