



<ul> <li>As of 31 December 2010, women in the UN system constituted:</li> <li>40.3% (12,005 out of 29,763) of all staff in the professional and higher categories with appointments of one year or more.</li> <li>22.7% (784 out of 2,674) of all staff at the D-1 level and above.</li> <li>29.3% (11,221 out of 27,089) of all staff at the P level;</li> <li>Gender balance has only been achieved at the P-2 (57.3%) level.</li> <li>Largest increase: UG (15.2% from 15.6% in Dec 2001 to 30.9% in Dec 2010)</li> <li>Smallest increase: P-2 (4.0% from 53.3% in Dec 2001 to 57.3% in Dec 2010)</li> </ul>					<ul> <li>As of 31 December 2010, women in WHO constituted:</li> <li>39.7% (863 out of 2172) of all staff in the professional and higher categories with appointments of one year or more.</li> <li>23.0% (61 out of 265) of all staff at the D-1 level and above.</li> <li>42.1% (802 out of 1907) of all staff at the P level.</li> <li>Gender balance has only been achieved or exceeded at P3(51.9%)level, P2(59.5%)level.</li> <li>Largest increase: UG(23.9% from 18.2% in Dec. 2001 to 42.1% in Dec. 2010)</li> <li>Largest decrease: D1(-2.9% from 25.3% in Dec 2001 to 22.4% in Dec 2010)</li> </ul>
