**United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea  
concluded at Montego Bay, Jamaica  
on 10 December 1982**

Receipt of an addendum to the partial Submission made by Canada to the  
Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf regarding its continental shelf in  
the Arctic Ocean

The Secretary-General of the United Nations communicates the following:

On 23 May 2019, Canada submitted to the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf, in accordance with article 76, paragraph 8, of the Convention, information on the limits of its continental shelf beyond 200 nautical miles from the baselines from which the breadth of its territorial sea is measured in the Arctic Ocean.

On 19 December 2022, Canada submitted an addendum to its partial Submission.

In accordance with the Rules of Procedure of the Commission (CLCS/40/Rev.1), the present communication is being circulated to all Member States of the United Nations, as well as States Parties to the Convention, in order to make public the executive summary of the addendum to the partial Submission, including all illustrative maps and coordinates contained therein.
