Subject: Information Session for UN Contractors using the Carrier Collaboration Portal (CCP) for Transportation Management

Dear Sir or Madam,

The UN Secretariat implemented a Transportation Management (TM) solution in 2019, based on SAP technology, including Events Management through a Carrier Collaboration Portal (CCP). This solution enables a more rapid, effective and responsive support for the UN's global supply chain operations. As part of this technology solution, a closer interaction between the UN and its contractors for goods and freight forwarding services is required, using the CCP.

The CCP is a web-based application used by contractors to upload shipping documentation and to submit transportation events for each leg of the shipment to the UN, providing near real time visibility. The UN uses this information in TM to plan, execute, and monitor shipments and troop movements efficiently. The solution enables a closer cooperation between the UN and its commercial partners and will become an essential requirement in most future contracts.

This session includes a system demonstration and is an opportunity to better understand how to gain access, seek technical support and clarify any questions you may have.
