DESCRIPTION OF REQUIREMENTS

The United Nations is seeking to establish contracts for provision of Long Term Air Charter Services for One Medium Fixed Wing Cargo aircraft, to be used in support of UNSOS, Somalia.

The aircraft must meet the specificrequirements described below, including the capacity to transport at least one 20 foot ISO container and a minimum of 20 Tons of cargo, and the ability to oeprate from/into the listed runways.

For this requirement, the UN will only contract with an AOC holder.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS / INFORMATION (IF ANY)

1. The Aircraft must be certified by the State of Registry as airworthy in accordance with (iaw) the standards contained in Annex 8 to the Convention on International Civil Aviation (the Convention), and fully meet the specifications set forth herein. A high level of serviceability is essential for satisfactory performance.

2. The initial operational base will be Mogadishu, Somalia.

3. Aircraft must be able to operate from the following locations but not limited to Baidoa, Belet Uen, Garowe, Kismayo, Nairobi, Mombasa, and Wajir. The aircraft shall be capable of performing with a minimum of 10 metric tons of cargo from the mentioned airports at the average temperature of +35 Degrees Celsius. Aircraft should be able to operate from unpaved runways such as Garowe and Belet Uen.

4. The proposed aircraft must also meet the following requirements:

- Air transportation services shall mainly include logistical re-supply.
 - The aircraft should fly with a payload of a minimum 20 metric tons
- Aircraft must be able to fly 80 hours per month.

• Aircraft must be capable to transport minimum one 20 Foot ISO container weighing minimum 10 metric tons.

- High altitude, Hot weather and Heavy operations capable.
- Aircraft capable of day/night VFR and IFR (all weather operations).

• All dangerous goods transported by air must be carried in compliance with ICAO Doc 9284. Typical Dangerous Goods include fuel, compressed gases, medical supplies, batteries and ammunition.

• The Carrier is required to be self-sufficient at the Opeartional Base and when tasked outside of the Mission area.

• Field self-start capability (APU) and capability to independently operate all systems and subsystems of the aircraft (i.e. cargo door, ramp, stairs etc.), if applicable.
