- 2. The services shall be on an as-and-when requested basis at the following locations: Elgenina, Al Daein, Nyala, Nyala Al Salam Kass, Zalinge and El Fasher.
- 3. UNAMID is seeking to engage qualified, competent and licenced companies authorised by the Government of Sudan to perform these services.
- 4. Companies intrested in providing the above services are invited to submit their expression of interest by e-mail or via hand delivery as indicated below along with required documents.
- 5. UNAMID will invite companies with capacity, experience and requiste licenses to execute these services.

1) Registering as a Vendor with the United Nations
