DESCRIPTION OF REQUIREMENTS

REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

1. The United Nations Organization Stabilization Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (MONUSCO), seeks Expression of Interest (EOI) from duly registered companies for the supply of various spare parts for MONUSCO in GOMA, DR CONGO.
2. MONUSCO will undertake a competitive bidding exercise shortly for a contract for an initial two-year period with provision for three optional extension periods of 1 year each based on satisfactory performance and MONUSCO's continual need (2+1+1+1) and accordingly intends to issue an Invitation to bid (ITB) to those companies who would express their interest and provide initial relevant information demonstrating their ability to fulfill MONUSCO requirements. Please note that MONUSCO reserves the right to split the award under this procurement exercise to more than one Bidder. The award(s) to the successful bidder(s) will be according the evaluation criteria described in the SOR (to be provided during the Invitation To Bid exercise) or in any combination at the MONUSCO's sole discretion. Consideration will be given to achieving



best value for money and on the basis of operational risk analysis from the UN perspective. Thus, a vendor can bid for all the line items or partially, the interested companies will be requested to complete UN Vendor registration for level 1 on the vendor database accessible on ungm.org (new vendor only). A detail Scope of Requirement (SOR) will be provided to companies short listed for receipt of the (ITB) documents.

3. The EOI should specify brief relevant information about the company including the company's profile, capacity/capability and experience. Vendors will be shortlisted based on their ability to provide the relevant documents showing a copy of manufacturer permit/authorization as a distributor authorized to supply the material. Interested vendors must provide the following documents with their response.

- Copy of the registration certificate/license (s) of the company.

4. Please note that this request for EOI is not an invitation for submission of bid.

MONUSCO reserves the right in selecting the invitees for the competitive bidding based on substantial and proven records of performance in the subject field of activities and submission of an EOI would not automatically warrant receipt of the (ITB) documents MONUSCO reserves the right to reject EOI's received after the deadline indicated below.

La Mission de l'Organisation des Nations Unies pour la Stabilisation en République Démocratique du Congo (MONUSCO) sollicite la manifestation d'intérêt (EOI) d'entreprises dûment enregistrées pour la fourniture de diverses pièces d'échange pour les générateurs à être livrées à GOMA, République Démocratique du Congo.

2. MONUSCO entreprendra sous peu un exercice d'appel d'offres pour un contrat d'une durée initiale de deux ans avec une disposition pour trois périodes de prolongation facultatives d'un an chacune en fonction de résultats satisfaisants et des besoins continus de la MONUSCO (2+1 + 1 + 1) et établira un document de sollicitation aux sociétés qui auront exprimé leur intérêt et auront fourni des informations pertinentes initiales démontrant leur capacité à satisfaire les exigences de la MONUSCO. Veuillez noter que la MONUSCO se réserve le droit de diviser l'attribution dans le cadre de cet exercice de passation de marchés à plusieurs soumissionnaires. EOI INSTRUCTIONS

1) Registering as a Vendor with the United Nations

Vendors interested in fulfilling the requirement described above must be registered at the UN Global Marketplace (www.ungm.org) with the UN Secretariat in order to be eligible to participate in any solicitation. Information on the registration process can be found at <https://www.un.org/Depts/ptd/vendors>.

Prerequisites for Eligibility

In order to be eligible for UN registration, you must declare that:

- A. Your company (as well as any parent, subsidiary or affiliate companies) is not listed in, or associated with a company or individual listed in:
 - I. the Compendium of United Nations Security Council Sanctions Lists (<https://www.un.org/sc/suborg/en/sanctions/un-sc-consolidated-list>), or
 - II. the IIC Oil for Food List website or, if listed on either, this has been disclosed to the United Nations Procurement Division in writing.
- B. Your company (as well as any parent, subsidiary or affiliate companies) is not currently removed or suspended by the United Nations or any other UN organisation (including the World Bank);
- C. Your company (as well as any parent, subsidiary or affiliate companies) is not under formal investigation, nor have been sanctioned within the preceding three (3) years, by any national authority of a United Nations Member State for engaging or having engaged in proscribed practices, including but not limited to: corruption, fraud, coercion, collusion, obstruction, or any other unethical practice;
- D. Your company has not declared bankruptcy, are not involved in bankruptcy or receivership proceedings, and there is no judgment or pending legal action against your company that could impair your company's operations in the foreseeable future;
- E. Your company does not employ, or anticipate employing, any person(s) who is, or has been a UN staff member within the last year, if said UN staff member has or had prior professional dealings with the Vendor in his/her capacity as UN staff member within the last three years of service with the UN (in accordance with UN post-employment restrictions published in ST/SGB/2006/15).
- F. Your company undertakes not to engage in proscribed practices (including but not limited to: corruption, fraud, coercion, collusion, obstruction, or any other unethical practice), with the UN or any other party, and to conduct business in a manner that averts any financial, operational, reputational or other undue risk to the UN.
