This Stand-Alone Technology stack kit should be designed to fully support an Electronic Discovery environment to cover the aspect of identifying, collecting and producing electronically stored information (ESI) in response to a request for production in an investigation. ESI includes, but is not limited to, emails, documents, presentations, databases, voicemail, pictures, audio and video files, social media, and web sites.

The eDiscovery kit shall support the hosting of Nuix software and Relativity software, procured separately by the UN and provided to the commercial vendor for installation on the kit.

Vendor shall provide a comprehensive description of their solution, including hardware specifications, full software stack integrated, backup solution, storage management, security components implemented and networking components alongside with support model.

The stand-alone technology stack ("kit") should be built using a synchronized baseline network of hardware, software and managed services considering the following minimum core requirments.

Nuix System: 8 users

Relativity System: 25-50 named users Virtualization Enviroment: Vmware/Hyper-V Professional Monitoring and Live Support: 24/7

The Hardware "kit" must be scaleable to meet the future expansion both interms of Compute and Storage.
