DESCRIPTION OF REQUIREMENTS

The United Nations intend to issue a solicitation in the next few months to establish a global system contract for the provision of rifle/carbine firearm for 5.56x45 NATO calibre. The Global System contract allowing all UN entities to place Purchase Order directly with the contract awarded Vendor (s) as per prices, terms and conditions stated in the final contract for the supply of rifle/carbine firearm will be awarded for an initial period of one (1) year with an option to extend for two additional 1-year periods (1+1+1) at the sole discretion of the UN and upon satisfactory performance of the contractor. The United Nations would like to understand some key aspects of the current market situation.

This comprehensive questionnaire is designed to gather detailed information from manufacturers and suppliers regarding the suitability and availability of rifle/carbine firearm options for UN field missions, with a focus on providing protection for low-risk environments to high-risk environments.

1) Registering as a Vendor with the United Nations

Vendors interested in fulfilling the requirement described above must be registered at the UN Global Marketplace (www.ungm.org) with the UN Secretariat in order to be eligible to participate in any solicitation. Information on the registration process can be found at https://www.un.org/Depts/ptd/vendors.

Prerequisites for Eligibility

In order to be eligible for UN registration, you must declare that:

- A. Your company (as well as any parent, subsidiary or affiliate companies) is not listed in, or associated with a company or individual listed in:
 - I. the Compendium of United Nations Security Council Sanctions Lists (https://www.un.org/securitycouncil/content/un-sc-consolidated-list), or
