### **DESCRIPTION OF REQUIREMENTS**

- 1. On behalf of the United Nations Suuport Office in Somalia (UNSOS), the United Nations Headquarters intends to contract 2 specialised AME/SAR/NVG/MPS rotary wing aircraft for a period of one (1) year plus two (2) optional one (1) year period, in support of UNSOS operations tio be stationed in Moghadishu, Somalia.
- 2. The operator shall provide the aircraft services mainly for Search and Rescue (SAR) and aeromedical evacuation (CASEVAC & MEDEVAC) operating day and night under VFR (including NVS) as well as day and night under IFR capability. The Aircraft shall be available 24/7. When needed the operator may also be required to undertake other types of services which may include logistic operations such as transportation of passengers and/or cargo point-to-point including transportation of Dangerous Goods (DG), surveillance/observation and general emergency evacuation.
- 3. The Aircraft shall be equipped with Night Vision System (NVS/NVG):

The Carrier must be authorized by the appropriate Civil Aviation Authority to perform NVG flights with the type of aircraft offered. The aircraft offered must be properly equipped and certified to perform NVG flights and SAR, as appropriate. Carrier's personnel, must be suitably trained, certified and experienced to perform NVG operations, as appropriate.

4. The Aircraft shall be equipped with Missile Protection System (MPS):

The Carrier must be authorized by the appropriate Civil Aviation Authority to perform flights with missile protection systems on the type of aircraft offered. The aircraft offered must be properly equipped and certified to perform flights with missile protection systems, as appropriate. Aircraft crews must be suitably trained, certified and experienced to perform flights with missile protection systems on the type of aircraft offered, as appropriate.

5. Aircraft shall be equipped with Infra-red camera system (Forward-Looking Infra-Red, or FLIR) capability

with ability to record as required for AME/SAR missions day or night and on 24/7 basis. An electro optical/infra-red surveillance FLIR system with steerable search light operating in visible and infra-red modes which is capable to detect and identify objects, perform quantitative and qualitative assessment of objects to record, store and transmit all video of photographic data is highly desirable.

### 6. AIRCRAFT CONFIGURATIONS:

- i) Aircraft must be capable to perform missions for a minimum of 15 adult passengers (85 Kg each) with 20 kg of personal luggage each on passenger configuration.
- ii) Aircraft must be capable of at least 250 NM range at minimum 100 kts normal cruise speed, without refuelling plus reserves for diversion. Aircraft must be capable of logistic re-supply missions using internal and external (sling) loads, capable to carry or lift a payload of at least 2,000 kg.
- iii) Aircraft must be able to transport a payload of at least 2,000 kg without refuelling at a distance of 250 NM.
- iv) For MEDEVAC/CASEVAC configuration, aircraft must be able to transport a payload of at least 700 kg to at least 400 NM (200 NM radius of operation without refuelling from the point of departure).
- v) Time required for aircraft configuration change must be less than 45 minutes to convert from full passenger configuration to full AME configuration, or vice-versa.
