DESCRIPTION OF REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (UNESCAP) is undergoing a new project aimed at reducing the environmental impact on cities in South East Asia of plastic waste pollution and leakage into the marine environment. The project will develop an innovative digital tool to assist local governments in South East Asia to monitor and visualize plastic waste leakage with a view to:
- i) prevent this waste from entering water streams and the ocean; and ii) improve identification of waste generation hot spots and improve their management at the municipal level. The project is expected to be completed in March 2021.
- 2. In this regard, UNESCAP is exploring the global market, to assess availability of credible vendors who have the capability, experience and a sound technical team to provide professional services in developing the tool and supporting the capacities of four South East Asian cities, to be selected by UNESCAP, in applying the tool to support more sustainable and effective municipal solid waste management systems.
- 3. Interested vendors should share relevant documentation pertinent to the development of this tool with their response to this RFI and may be contacted to participate in a videoconference with UNESCAP to share information on different methodologies, approaches and technology options for the implementation of the project's objectives.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS / INFORMATION (IF ANY)

The vendor will develop an Open Source Digital Tool (web-based software) that will visualize and map plastic waste flows and leakages through information captured by obervational and/or geographic information system (GIS) technologies deployed in four South East Asian cities. The Vendor will be responsible for producing data for the tool through application of technologies, sound methodologies, as well as collecting any relevant publically available data for each of the four selected cities.

The tool will provide the evidence base for the planning of strategic investments and policy interventions that offer the greatest impact and feasibility for addressing plastic waste pullution into the ocean and/or adjacent riverine bodies. The contribution of the digital tool to the overall project will be to map the quantities, sources and pathways of plastic entering the ocean from waste generated from land-based sources, in this case urbanized areas, in order to produce plastic waste leakage maps and scenarios for each city.

The vendor will also support the development of appropriate guidance to local government on the application of the digital tool in four South East Asian cities (to be selected by UNESCAP) by providing consultantcy services in support of training and other capacity development events and interventions which will result in the design of policy and investment measures with local government, business and consumers.

Based on the application of the digital tool, the four cities in South East Asian countries will develop policy and investment strategies in alignment with regional plans, namely the ASEAN Framework for Action on Marine Debris, to apply a circular economy approach in managing their plastic waste streams and consequently ensuring a healthy land and ocean environment. UNESCAP will leverage the outputs from the vendor and cities to support stronger local and national voluntary commitments to accelerate action on plastic waste pollution in South East Asia, including through relevant regional intergovernmental fora.

Vendors active in the areas of artificial intelligence and digital observation systems which can propose practical methologies to visualize plastic material flows using technology such as 360-degree cameras, drones and GIS mapping technologies would be attractive. UNESCAP will be fully engaged with the Vendor selected for the digital tool development and application in cities to ensure that the results of the Contract could be later be used for the development of policy, planning and investment solutions to address plastic waste pollution in a wider set of cities in the Asia and Pacific region.
