- 6 beneficiary countries (Indonesia, Kenya, Mauritania, Tajikistan, Togo, Tunisia).
- 3 new National Action Plans (roadmaps)
 developed for Indonesia, Kenya, and Tajikistan
 following in-depth consultations led by CTED.
- Developed a Training Curriculum on Vulnerable Targets Protection for Trainers - in English and French, which includes foundational, advanced and specialized levels of training.
- 8 specialized national capacity building activities held for beneficiary countries.



Innovative Projects & Partnership Building

- Developed new initiatives on protecting vulnerable targets through behavioural insights, tourism and cultural property, safeguarding religious sites, and protecting educational institutions.
- 8 High-Level Coordination and Expert activities organized, including the Programme's first Steering Committee; launch of knowledge tool at UNOCT's Madrid Office; and an Expert Group Meeting in UNOCT's Rabat Office.
- 8 outreach activities held with partners such as AU/ACSRT, EU, NATO, INTERPOL and OSCE.
