IN FOCUS: ENGAGEMENT WITH THE GCTF

UNOCT, through the Counter-Terrorism Compact Secretariat, facilitates coordinated engagement of the UN system with the Global Counterterrorism Forum (GCTF)

- The 5th UN-GCTF coordination meeting was held recently (17 Sept.)
- UNOCT led the UN delegation to the 17th meeting of the GCTF Coordination Committee and provided an update on the efforts of the Counter-Terrorism Compact (29 Sept.)
- UNOCT signed a [MoU](#) with the IJ – the International Institute for Justice and the Rule of Law (Sep.) and has now MoUs with all GCTF-inspired institutions (also Hedayah and GCERF - the Global Community Engagement and Resilience Fund)
- UNOCT/UNCCT, the Netherlands and Morocco launched a joint UN-GCTF [Initiative](#) on Ensuring the Implementation of **Countering the Financing of Terrorism Measures while Safeguarding the Civic Space** (13 Oct.)

The Platform, launched in March 2020, was developed and is maintained by UNOCT thanks to the financial support of the State of Qatar.
